Background to the Event

The International Standards Organization (ISO) is establishing global standards for the capture, transport and storage of CO₂. The committee setting these technical standards (TC265) meets several times a year, and annually holds a full plenary session involving CCS experts from industries, governments, and scientific communities of 24 different member countries developing standards for the different components of CCS (such as transport, capture, injection, CO₂-EOR and storage).

The annual plenary meeting is being hosted by the PTRC in 2023 at the Hotel Saskatchewan in Regina June 5th to 9th. It will involve two days of working group meetings, two days of plenary/conference presentations, and a one-day site visit to SaskPower's Boundary Dam CCS Facility, the Aquistore storage site, and Whitecap's Weyburn CO₂-EOR operations. A morning session will be made available to sponsors to meet with the senior members of the Technical Committee, and to learn more about the standards.
